

BOARD MINUTES
Thursday, Feb. 15, 1872
Court House

The Mayor and Aldermen met at the Court House. Present: Mayor Clark, Aldermen Deberry, Pinner, McAllister, Roberts and Sampson.

On motion G.D. McAllister was appointed by the Board, Fire Warden instead of J.T. Dalton resigned.

On motion it is ordained that all persons be required to make the alterations suggested by the Fire Warden within five days.

On motion the account of Battle & Neasn for \$4.00 for hauling was allowed.

On motion a committee, to wit: Aldermen Pinner, Roberts and Miller were appointed to report on the propriety and expediency of buying a fire engine.

On motion the committee, Aldermen Deberry, McAllister, Pinner and Mayor Clark were authorized to receive bids for building a plank walk to the Female Academy and have the plank walk built.

On motion the proposition to let out the work of keeping the streets in repair to one man was made the special order for next meeting.

On motion the Marshal was directed to clear off all obstructions on the street at once.

On motion the Board adjourned.
