

BOARD MEETING
Thursday, June 5, 1873
Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of Dyersburg met at the Court House on this Thursday night June 5th 1873.

Present Mayor Clark, aldermen Coker, DeBerry, McAllister, Pinner, Sampson & Doyle and Marshal Nichols.

The minutes of the last meeting were read, approved and signed.

The Mayor stated that he has received a letter from Jno L. Norton of the Memphis Paducah RR which was ad notifying him that he had received a Certificate of Stock issued to Dyersburg for \$50 M and that the same was deposited in the German National Bank subject to the order of the Mayor – and that he had such an order therefore by F. W. Luscombe – which action on the part of the Mayor was duly ratified.

On motion Aldermen McAllister, DeBerry & Pinner were appointed to confer with Memphis ____, Sampson & others having fire proof safes for sale – and see about what price a safe suitable for the use of the Mayor and Aldermen can be obtained – and that they report to this Board at its next regular meeting.

On motion the Privilege Tax of Mrs. Hames – Milliners – of Five Dollars for 1873, was remitted – and the Recorder instructed to issue to her a license for 1873 without charge to her.

On motion Twenty Five Dollars is allowed and ordered to be paid to W. C. Doyle – for money paid to the street commissioner on the 16th of May – all the Aldermen voting for it.

On motion One Dollar was allowed and ordered to be paid to W. C. Doyle on account of money paid for M.A. Crop – he having collected only \$9.00 and Crop having left the town – all the Aldermen voting for the same.

On motion the sum of One Hundred and Four Dollars & 52 Cents being account due J. M. Nichols on Settlement of Taxes of 1872, as per report of the Auditing Committee as submitted to the meeting of this Board on the 20th of February 1873 – was allowed and ordered to be paid to said Nichols – all the Aldermen voting in favor of the same.

The Report of the Surveyor and Committee appointed to mark out and define the streets in Hales addition was presented – and postponed until the next regular meeting.

Mayor Clark presented his resignation as Mayor and also as Alderman – which said resignation was laid on the table until the next meeting.

On motion the Board adjourned until tomorrow night.
