

**BOARD MEETING  
June 16, 1873  
Court House**

**The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met at the Courthouse in Dyersburg on this 16<sup>th</sup> of June 1873 at the call of the Mayor.**

**Present Mayor Pinner, Aldermen Coker, DeBerry, McAllister, Sugg and Doyle and Marshal Nichols.**

**The reading of the minutes of the last meeting was dispensed with –**

**Ordered by the Board that the Recorder be and is hereby directed to make out an assessment of the taxable property and poll, in the Corporate limits, for the present year – and that said assessment be and confirm to that made and to be made by the State – and that on the completion of said assessment that the same be recorded in assetbound “Record Tax Book” – and a copy thereof be furnished by said Recorder, to the Marshal.**

**On motion the sum of Ten Dollars was allowed and ordered to be paid to W. C. Doyle for T. A. Jordan’s account (for buggy hire – in May 1873 – in carrying the Committee to examine the Rail Road – as ordered 10 – May cash) – all the Aldermen voting for said allowance.**

**On motion it is ordered that Marshal Nichols contract for and have erected suitable and substantial hitching posts (at least six feet out of the ground) – to be set in the ground around the Court House yard – and that he also have the horse racks repaired.**

**On motion the Board adjourned until the next regular meeting.**
