

BOARD MEETING
March 5, 1874
Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of Dyersburg met in regular session this 1st Thursday evening, March 5, 1874 at Court House.

Present Mayor Neal, Aldermen Deberry, Thurman, Wilson and White.

The Minutes of the last meeting were read, approved and signed.

The committee appointed at last meeting to inspect bridge at ware house, report that in their opinion the Bridge is in sufficient repair for present purposes and recommend that there be nothing done with it at present. Their report was received, adopted and the committee discharged.

The committee appointed to assess taxes for 1874, on giving sufficient reasons for not making a report at this meeting, and having asked for further time, it was granted.

On motion it was ordained that the property owners on the south side of Public Square be required to put down a pavement in front of their property of either brick or plank as they may prefer, if plank is used, streamers put down like the walk to Methodist Church will be sufficient, this work to be done by the next regular meeting of the Board and the Marshall is hereby directed to inform the parties of the same.

A committee was appointed by the Mayor to examine the assessment of W. H. Gillint's property for 1873 for the purpose of ascertaining whether said property was assessed to high and if so, what deduction is proper to make, Aldermen Wilson and Deberry committee.

On motion it was ordered that should the Mayor be absent at any time during this and our next regular meeting that Alderman F. G. Sampson is hereby appointed to act as Mayor Protem.

On motion Board adjourned.
