

**BOARD MEETING  
December 3, 1874  
Court House**

**The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular meeting at the Court Hose this Thursday evening December 3, 1874.**

**Present Mayor Neal, Aldermen Wilson, Deberry, Sampson, Thurman, Sugg & White and Marshall McClerkin.**

**The minutes of the last meeting was read, approved and signed.**

**A report from the committee on cemetery affairs was presented and a motion received.**

**When on motion from Alderman Deberry said report was laid on the Table for future action.**

**On motion the following accounts was allowed one in favor of Jno. M. Pierce for \$52.15 for services as Marshall subject to deduction of fines collected by him and to settle with the Mayor and Recorder, one in favor of Sugg for \$1.75 for 1 horse collar, one in favor of Neal & \_\_\_\_ \$8.00 for painting, one favor Deberry & White 55.00 for candles.**

**A proposition from Jno. W. Harten to exchange land for a portion of cemetery was presented when on motion, the Recorder was ordered to endorse on said proposition, Disapproved and Respectfully returned.**

**On motion of F. G. Sampson the following allowances was made to the offices for their services for the year 1874 and ordered to be paid, to wit:**

**To Tom W. Neal as Mayor – One Hundred Dollars**

**To A. C. White as Recorder & Treasurer One Hundred & Fifty Dollars**

**To L. C. McClerkin as Marshall from Sept. 1 to 31 Dec. 1874 One Hundred Dollars**

**On motion the Mayor appointed Aldermen Sugg and Sampson a committee to settle with the Recorder and Marshall and to report at next meeting.**

**On motion Board adjourned to meet the evening before the meeting of the next Board.**
