BOARD MEETING September 5, 1875

Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular

meeting at the Court House this Tuesday evening the 5th day of September 1875.

Present Mayor Sugg, Aldermen Stevens, Smither, Pinner, Thurman, Deberry &

White and Marshall Fowlkes.

The minutes of the last meeting were read, approved and signed.

Aldermen Smither asked to be excused from the meeting, which request was

granted by the Mayor.

On motion it was ordered that a warrant for the sum of Ten 00/100 Dollars be

issued to R. A. W. James Esq. in payment of his fee for successfully defending the case of

indictment against the Corporation.

On motion it was ordered that a warrant for Two 00/100 Dollars be issued to Joseph

Fannin for digging grave for Mr. York's child.

On motion it was ordered that a warrant for One Hundred & Fifty Four 86/100

Dollars be issued to A. M. Stevens in payment for lumber furnished by him for bridge in

Court Street, also the sum of Eighty 14/100 Dollars be paid F. H. Batton for building said

bridge (these two sums making up the amount of Two Hundred & thirty five 00/100

Dollars, that being the amount contracted for with said Battton for said work).

On motion it was ordered that a warrant for Ten 00/100 Dollars be issued to F. H.

Batton for extra work done on bridge and side walk.

On motion the sum of six 60/100 Dollars was allowed A. M. Stevens for extra lumber

furnished by him for said bridge.

On motion it was ordered that this Board will appropriate the sum of One Hundred

& Twenty five 00/100 Dollars toward equipping a hook & ladder company, whenever such

a company is organized in the Town of Dyersburg.

On motion it was ordered that a committee of Three be appointed to make a proper

investment of the above amount for said purpose whereupon the mayor appointed

Aldermen J. C. Pinner, E. S. Thurman & N. C. White – committee.

On motion Board adjourned.
