BOARD MEETING April 1, 1878

Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular

meeting at the Court House this Monday evening the 1st day of April 1878

Present Mayor Clarke, Aldermen Nichols, Sawyers, Miller, Thurmond, Scott &

White and Marshal Ferguson.

The minutes of the last meeting were read, approved and signed.

Alderman Thurmond tendered his resignation as Alderman, when on motion it was

ordered that the resignation of Alderman Thurmond be and is hereby accepted.

The committee appointed at last meeting for the purpose of contracting for suitable

lumber for plank walks reported that they had made a contract with Meprs Hobby & Son

for said lumber and that the parties were now delivering the lumber upon the ground when

it was needed, when on motion it was ordered that the report be received and the

committee discharged.

The committee appointed to further investigate the tax question reported that in

their opinion, in order to raise sufficient revenue to meet current expenses there would

have to be a privilege tax levied on all dealers carrying less than \$2,500.00 stock, of \$7.50

and on all carrying over that amount .30 cents on the one hundred dollars; advalorem.

After considerable discussion of this question on motion it was ordered that all

business houses or dealers doing business in this town shall pay a privilege tax of not less

than Ten 00/100 Dollars (\$10.00) and all dealers carrying over Two Thousand dollars

(\$2,000.00) stock shall pay an additional advalorem privilege tax of .15 cents on each one

hundred dollars in excess of that amount, the amount of stock on hand the 15th day of April

1878 to be reported and subject to this tax the following tax was levied on saloons \$10.00 on

livery stables \$10.00 on photographers \$5.00 on tinners who deal in stoves and

manufactured articles \$5.00 on milliners \$5.00 on all billiard tables or any other kind of

tables kept and play for profit a tax of \$2.50.

On motion it was ordered that a committee be appointed to let out the building of

the plank walks by specification to the lowest bidder, Mayor Clarke, Aldermen Miller and

Nichols were appointed committee.

When on motion Board adjourned.
