

**BOARD MEETING  
July 1, 1878  
Court House**

**The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met at Court House in regular meeting this Monday evening the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 1878.**

**Present Mayor Clarke, Aldermen Scott, Nichols, Miller & White and Marshal Ferguson.**

**The minutes of last meeting were read, approved and signed.**

**On motion it was ordered that the amount of Eleven 00/100 Dollars (\$11.00) be allowed for old bridge timbers bought by the Mayor from the county at public sale by J. C. Pinner Commissioner and that a warrant be issued to said J. C. Pinner Commissioner for same.**

**On motion it was ordered that the amount of Ten 00/100 Dollars collected from Dick Benton Cold as a Merchants Privilege Tax be refunded to him it appearing to the Board that he is not a merchant and that a warrant be issued to him for that amount.**
