

**BOARD MEETING  
October 7, 1878  
Court House**

**The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular meeting at the Court House this the 7<sup>th</sup> day of October 1878.**

**Present Mayor Clark, Aldermen Nichols, Parr, Miller, Sawyers, Scott & White.**

**The minutes of the last regular meeting and a called meeting were read, approved and signed.**

**The committee appointed to examine the tax books submitted a written report showing amount taxes due for 1877 and fines due for 1878.**

**When on motion it was ordered that the report be received and filed with the Corporation papers and committee discharged.**

**On motion of Alderman Miller it was ordered that a vote of thanks from this Board be tendered to Alderman Sawyers for the public spirit manifested by him in constructing a well in the street for the benefit of the public.**

**On motion it was ordered that the sum of Ten 00/100 Dollars be allowed to Mrs. York to enable her and her children to move to Henderson Station M.O.R.R. where her kins people live.**
