## BOARD MEETING April 3, 1882 Court House

Board of Mayor and Aldermen for Town of Dyersburg met at Court House on 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April 1882.

Present Mayor B. L. Thomas, Aldermen Stevens, A. B. Jones, Jno. M. Nichols, W. E. DeBerry and W. R. Hayes and Marshal Nichols.

Minutes of last meeting read and signed.

On motion A. M. Stevens and A. B. Jones appointed committee to have walk running from Webbs corner to grist mill repaired.

On motion report of committee allowing W. B. Tarrant Four Dollars on jail fees was allowed, ordered paid.

On motion account in favor ? for six and 55/100 dollars, allowed.

On motion account in favor J. W. ? & Co. for \$1.00 medicine to Craig allowed.

On motion account in favor Roberts & Yeargin for \$4.30 supplies to Small Pox cases allowed.

On motion account in favor Jno. McGuinnis for .50 cents mending wheelbarrow allowed.

On motion account R. McGaughey referred to committee Jno. W. Nichols & A. B. Jones.

Motion to arrest any person privilege of serving ice, lemonade and beer on Sunday was lost.

On motion H. Tindle was allowed eighty five dollars (85.00) for household goods and ? ? lost by burning of small pox house.

On motion following committee was appointed to have lamp placed on each corner of the public square and have them lighted in most expedient way.

On motion W. E. DeBerry was appointed committee to have the wells around the square put in order so water could be obtained thru them.

On motion it was declared to be the sense of this Board that card playing in any business or out house within the Corporation is a nuisance and the Marshall is ordered to arrest any party or parties so doing and they shall be fined not less than Two and 50/100 dollars nor more than Twenty five dollars for each offence.

On motion Board changed meeting night to first Tuesday night of each month. On motion lumber to build dog trot walk to Col M. E. Church was allowed provided col. people build said walk, A. B. Jones was appointed to make out bid for lumber superintend building.

On motion Board adjourned to meet first Tuesday night in May.
