

BOARD MEETING
July 4, 1882
Court House

At a regular meeting of Board of Mayor and Aldermen for Town of Dyersburg held in Court House July 4, 1882.

Present Mayor B. L. Thomas, Aldermen W. E. DeBerry, Jno. W. Nichols, Ed Smith, A. B. Jones, W. R. Hayes and Marshall Nichols.

Minutes of last meeting read and signed.

On motion committee to settle with W. B. Tarrant allowed further time.

On motion committee on taxing wagons and water carts read committee discharged and on motion a privilege tax of \$5.00 on wagons and \$3.00 on water carts that run for pay in Corporation as a business was ordered.

On motion committee report on settlement with A. M. Stevens read committee discharged.

An account in favor of A. W. Stevens for three hundred sixty nine and 32/100 dollars which is in full to date of June 16, 1882.

On motion ordinance was passed prohibiting blacksmiths on the square from shoeing horses on the streets and in front and of their shops.

On motion W. H. Tucker as allowed Twenty Dollars on pump in public well in front of hotel.

On motion account in favor Nichols & Roberts allowed \$5.00.

On motion account in favor of Stems & Bros for lumber \$208.68 allowed subject to correction.

On motion accounting favor Jackson and Nichols allowed for \$6.90 subject to correction.

On motion account in favor B. L. Thomas \$4.00 allowed.

On motion Jno. Benson was released of \$40.00 of fine for selling beer on Sunday.

On motion committee E. W. Smith and A. B. Jones was appointed to have walk and bridges repaired leading to Isom yard east of Sugg Hotel.

On motion Board adjourned to meet 1st Tuesday night in August.
