

BOARD MEETING
October 2, 1883
Court House

Regular meeting of Board of Mayor and Aldermen for Town of Dyersburg was held at Court House on Tuesday night October 2, 1883.

Present Mayor B. L. Thomas, Aldermen Ed Smith, Z. G. Watkins, A. B. Jones, J. W. Baker, J. C. Pinner and W. R. Hayes and Marshal Thurmond.

Minutes of last meeting read, approved and signed.

On motion further time was allowed committee to settle with Jim Nichols. Committee on sheds and signs reported the following as condemned: Watson, Smith, Berdin Baker & Co. Smith, Harton, Sugg, Williams, Goldsmith, DeBerry, Jones, Alston Barber Shop, Parr Nolen & Co and T. W. Neals signs. On motion report was read and committee discharged and Marshal Thurmond instructed to have the same repaired or torn down.

On motion report of committee appointed to examine and say what such ought to be allowed for certain brick walks was read, committee discharged and on motion tax receipt ordered to be drawn in favor of following parties in payment of this inspection payments:

M. M. Marshall Twenty six & 25/100 dollars - \$26.25

J. R. Baker & Co. Twenty Four Dollars - \$24.00

B. M. Williams nineteen & 20/100 - \$19.20

Jno. Sawyers eighteen - \$18.00

Jno W. Wilson nine - \$9.00

On motion following account was allowed:

A. M. Stevens one hundred & twenty four & 38/100 dollars - \$124.38

Jno. W. McGuinnis one & 25/100 dollars - \$1.25

On motion rate of taxes for year 1883 was made fifty cents on \$100.00 and polls \$1.00 for the Corporation of Dyersburg, Tennessee.

On motion E. S. Thurmond was allowed to put the front back to shed on Parr Nolen's corner.

On motion the old blacksmith shop formerly occupied by Parson Lane was declared a nuisance and Marshal ordered to have it nailed up or torn down.

On motion alley west of Jno. L. Webb ? G. E. Scott was ordered to be opened clear through to the river. On motion Marshal was instructed to notify J. T. Crass to remove the dam in braush east of Suggs Hotel immediately.

On motion Board adjourned.
