On motion report of committee on lamps for Depot Street was read and committee discharged.

On motion E. W. Smith was continued on committee to get the right-of-way for widening the street west of B. L. Thomas.

On motion committee on Tucker Hotel sewer was discharged.

On motion the ordinance in regard to deaths and births in Corporation was ordered published – if low rates could be obtained.

On motion a committee was appointed to have the walk continued from the Baptist Church to Hayes corner and from Doyles to Philigus gate on St. John Street – E. W. Smith.

On motion Wm. Turner was appointed to look after several poor families reported to be in destitute circumstances.

On motion Marshal Smith was instructed to purchase a coal oil truck and 1 BBl of coal oil for Corporation.

On motion Marshal was employed to take charge of street lights provided he would do so for .50 cents per lamp per month.
