On motion committee on leasing lot to Standard Oil Co. allowed.

Committee was appointed to see what the cost of keeping the public pump in order for twelve months would be J. W. Brackin.

On motion committee on walk from Jno. Parkers to Fowlkes Street was appointed – Wm. Turner.

On motion committee on selling adulterated food in Corporation was appointed – W. R. Hayes.

On motion following accounts were allowed:

On motion committee on damages to E. C. Pate allowed more time, Watkins, Turner and Thomas.

On motion Marshal was ordered to have the yard of J. P. Thurmond graded and put the dirt on Depot Street.

On motion Marshal was ordered to have St. John Street – between Hayes and Sampson properly worked.

On motion J. W. Brackin was elected to serve on joint school board instead of J. W. Parr who declined to serve when elected.

On motion an elected was taken for Aldermen to serve the unexpired term of Jno. Sinclair which resulted in the elected of Capt. Geo. B. Miller as Alderman for remainder of year 1887.

Marshal was instructed to have banisters put on walk from Nash Jones to Mrs. McAlisters.

On motion Board elected Jeff Vaughn Dep. Marshal for Dyersburg at the request of Marshal Smith. No further business appearing, Board adjourned
